Jr, High Section

If there is space, place the Jr. High section away from the K-5th graders.



K-5th Grade Section:

If you are using 4 tables per row, it is nice to crate an aisle down the middle for the floor staff. Younger players should be towards the entrance, older players should be farther from the entrance.



Signs should be placed on the ends of the tables, so kids can find their games:



The scorers tables can be placed in the hall leading to the tournament room or in the tournament room. You need at least two tables & 4 chairs. It needs to be in a place where the kids can't leave without reporting their scores. This is also a good place to have extra notation sheets and pencils. The kids can pick them up no their way to their game.






Chess Board setup

they bring to tournaments.


Boards and pieces are also supplied by BNASC.


There needs to be space for teams to hang out between games. Some venues have individual class rooms while others use cafeteria and halls.
